How will we spend the grant this academic year?

The money we receive this year will be spent in the following way to ensure Primary PE objectives are met in a sustainable way.

Appointment of PE Staff Team

- More opportunities for children to participate in clubs and competitions
- Support for teachers in the set up and delivery of all areas of the PE curriculum
- Smaller group sizes leading to improvement in the quality of PE provision
- Additional staff to work with small groups to provide additional support and challenge
- Teachers are able to work alongside these specialists to develop their understanding of good practice in the teaching of dance.

Barnet Schools Sports Partnership

- Enables us to participate in competitions, festivals and coaching opportunities across a wide range of sports
- Provides ongoing CPD opportunities for staff and specialists to develop teaching and learning throughout the PE curriculum.

Additional Bought in Services

• Additional specialist teaching to enhance cultural capital - fencing, karate, taekwondo etc.

Purchasing of PE planning scheme

 Purchasing of plans and resources to help develop confidence and competence in teaching different elements of PE.

Purchasing of equipment

- All children will have resources available for maximum engagement in all PE lessons i.e. whole class sets of rackets, hockey sticks etc.
- Diversity in resources available and accessible so that we can offer a wide range of sporting opportunities i.e. lacrosse.

Release time for teachers to work with specialist

- Teachers can develop their competence and confidence in a range of PE areas
- Better quality PE lessons through team teaching and disseminating good practice
